My Brethren,

In 1863, our great nation was going through a terrible ordeal. As Lincoln described in his October 3rd message, “There have been needful diversions of wealth and of strength from the fields of peaceful industry. There has been financial dislocation and economic fears, jobs lost, a pandemic that continues to hover over our world, old fault lines reopening, dividing neighbor from neighbor, many ill and too many called to the Lodge on High; and yet we still have much to be thankful for. You are the beacon of Light illuminating the world, bringing love, charity, hope and unity to our great nation.
